TSLGBTQ+ PRIDE COMMITTEE RECAP

In March, we invited a **children's author** to meet with Kindergarten classes on the theme of different types of families, stories inside of each of us, which linked well with the **McMurrich Voices initiative**. We received great feedback from staff.

Additionally, the Committees **representatives attended the TDSB EnVision Conference** hosted at Oakwood Collegiate Institute, **to honour and celebrate 2SLGBTQIAP+ communities**, and to network with teachers, parents, students and community on issues faced across Ontario in addressing homophobia and transphobia. The focus of this year's conference is 2SLGBTQIAP+ Indigenous, Black, and Racialized Joy, Intersections, and Futurity.

In April, the Committee organized for **A Little Red Theatre** to deliver a series of theatre workshops that will continue through the Spring with McMurrich's Pride Club; it involves the making of a short video of the Pride Club's creative work. We will also be painting a series of artworks for the McMurrich Voices art project; the paintings will be displayed in the north stairwell of the school.

TREASURY RECAP

Thank you to our school community for contributing so generously to our recent fundraisers:



- Dance-A-Thon raised \$4,248.13 (for dash and dot robots)
- Wine Survivor raised \$1,840.00
- Marlies tickets raised \$876.00
- The Silent Auction Teaser raised \$3,602.00
- Pizza lunch has made \$10,402 to-date with 2 more to go
- The Super **BIG Silent Auction** raised **\$13,615** (minus expenses, with a few receipts and payments pending)
- We expect the Fun Fair on June 1 to also raise money for the school as well

Over the past month the school council has funded a multi classroom author visit from Cory Silverberg on behalf of the Pride committee, a science workshop through York University, a Kinder trip to Downey's Farm, purchased a butterfly larvae set for the kinder classrooms, and contributed to supply purchases for the school wide Voices art project. We encourage teachers with remaining enrichment funds to put in their requests before the last week of school.

Funds we raise through the school council goes towards: enrichment initiatives for students, technology for the students, teachers for enriching the curriculum for their class, sports & music equipment, the playground rejuvenation, subsidising field trips, educational speakers, OPAL equipment, throwing a graduation for grade 6 students and much more.
