Library Update

In Library news, there are a few items to share with our school community. Last week I had the opportunity to attend the GTA Resource Fair at the Exhibition Grounds. Every year, the TDSB and various book publishers and retailers organize this event for schools in the region. It is a great opportunity to browse books and other resources for our school library. While it was hard to stay within our budget because of all the great materials to choose from, we did purchase some amazing new titles that I am excited to introduce to students and staff in the coming weeks! The first part of our shipment arrived earlier this week and some of the titles have already made their way into classrooms - I look forward to hearing about these new books and the discussions they elicit during read alouds and of course, the recommendations that students share with their classmates and friends. The selections made encompass nonfiction related to the Social Studies and Science Curriculum, novels, picture books, early reader books, Canadian content and works by local authors. We also have added to our graphic novel collection, many of which have a social justice theme or are related to our ongoing work with anti oppression, antiracism and general interest. More titles will be arriving from the TDSB Library Distribution Centre soon (I hope), ready to hit the shelves!

We are also waiting (im)patiently for our Forest of Reading Titles to arrive. As always, McMurrich is participating in the Forest of Reading program again. As books come in, we look forward to sharing the Blue Spruce program with our Kindergarten and primary classes, Silver Birch Express with the primary and junior classes, Silver Birch with our Juniors and for some of our older readers, the Red Maple Series. All these books are by Canadian authors and historically have been exceptional reads! We will be starting up our Forest of Reading programs and activities in the New Year - stay tuned!
